Steven J. Malcolm was named chairman of Williams in May 2002, CEO in January 2002 and president and chief operating officer of Williams in September 2001. In 1998, he was named president and CEO of Williams Energy Services. Malcolm was named senior vice president and general manager of Midstream Gas & Liquids for Williams Energy Services in 1996.

He served as senior vice president and general manager of Gathering & Processing for Williams Field Services from 1994-96. Prior to that, Malcolm was senior vice president and general manager of the Mid-Continent region, Williams Field Services. He served as vice president of Gas Management and Supply from 1989 to 1993 and director of gas management from 1986-89 for Williams Natural Gas Company. Malcolm joined Williams in 1984 as director of business development, Williams Natural Gas Company. Prior to joining Williams, he worked for Cities Gas Company in refining, marketing and transportation services.

Malcolm graduated from the University of Missouri-Rolla in 1970 with a bachelor's in civil engineering. He has also attended advanced management training courses at Northwestern University.
