## **Williams' Transco Pipeline Seeks Public Comment on Proposed Expansion**

PRINCETON, N.J. – Williams' (NYSE:WMB) Transco pipeline system will hold an informational open house from 6 to 8 p.m. on Feb. 23 at the Ramada Inn in Bordentown, N.J.

Due to the growing demand for clean-burning natural gas, plans are underway to expand Transco's existing pipeline facilities in Bordentown and Mansfield Townships. Transco is investigating several possible routes for the proposed pipeline, all of which parallel the New Jersey Turnpike.

Residents are encouraged to come learn about the project and provide suggestions early in the planning process. Transco's representatives will be available to discuss how interstate pipelines are approved, built and operated to assure safety, environmental protection and dependable energy supplies.
