Time and Absence: Non-Exempt 9/80 Fridays Floating Holiday Request

9/80 Non-Exempt Friday Time Entry

If you are a Non-Exempt 9/80 schedule employee taking time off on a Friday that you are *normally scheduled to work*, you must enter your request directly on your timesheet (<u>not</u> via the Absence application).

1. To get started, first navigate to the **Time** application on the Workday homepage:



2. From the Enter Time column, click the week for which you'd like to request a working Friday off.



3. Once the selected timesheet is open, click the Enter Time button and then select Enter Time by Type. In the Time Type column, select 9-80 Friday – Floating Holiday (days).





4. After selecting the Time Type, enter .5 on the Friday you are scheduled to work but are taking a Floating Holiday. The .5 is equivalent to half a day (the AM hours that go with the current work week).

NOTE: The remaining .5 for the PM hours will display on Saturday of the following week once your time has been entered for the week.

 - **NOTE:** Although the Floating Holiday <=12/31/2019 plan displays, it is inactive and will be removed at the beginning of the first full pay period in 2020 on 1/4/2020.
