Glen Jasek became Senior Vice President of Transmission, Power & Gulf at Williams in February 2026. Previously, Jasek served as Vice President and General Manager of Northwest Pipeline LLC, leading the Northwest Pipeline business, as well as overseeing several Williams gathering and processing franchises and natural gas liquids assets. Earlier, he was Director of Environmental Services for Williams.

Since joining Williams in 1995, Jasek has held various roles in Operations, Projects, Safety, and Environmental.
