ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Green River West Expansion Project is a proposed natural gas infrastructure project in Sweetwater County, Wyoming, designed to support energy reliability and emissions reduction at an existing industrial facility.

The project includes construction of a new pipeline and associated delivery infrastructure to provide natural gas service to industrial customers in the area.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Construction activities will follow federal safety and environmental requirements and include erosion control, restoration and monitoring.

- **Pipeline installation along existing right-of-way**
- **Use of trenchless construction methods (e.g., horizontal directional drilling) where appropriate**
- **Connecting to existing infrastructure with two new delivery points**
- **Temporary workspaces for safe efficient construction**
- **Construction of a meter station and associated facilities**

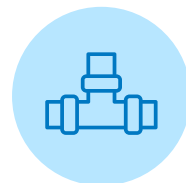

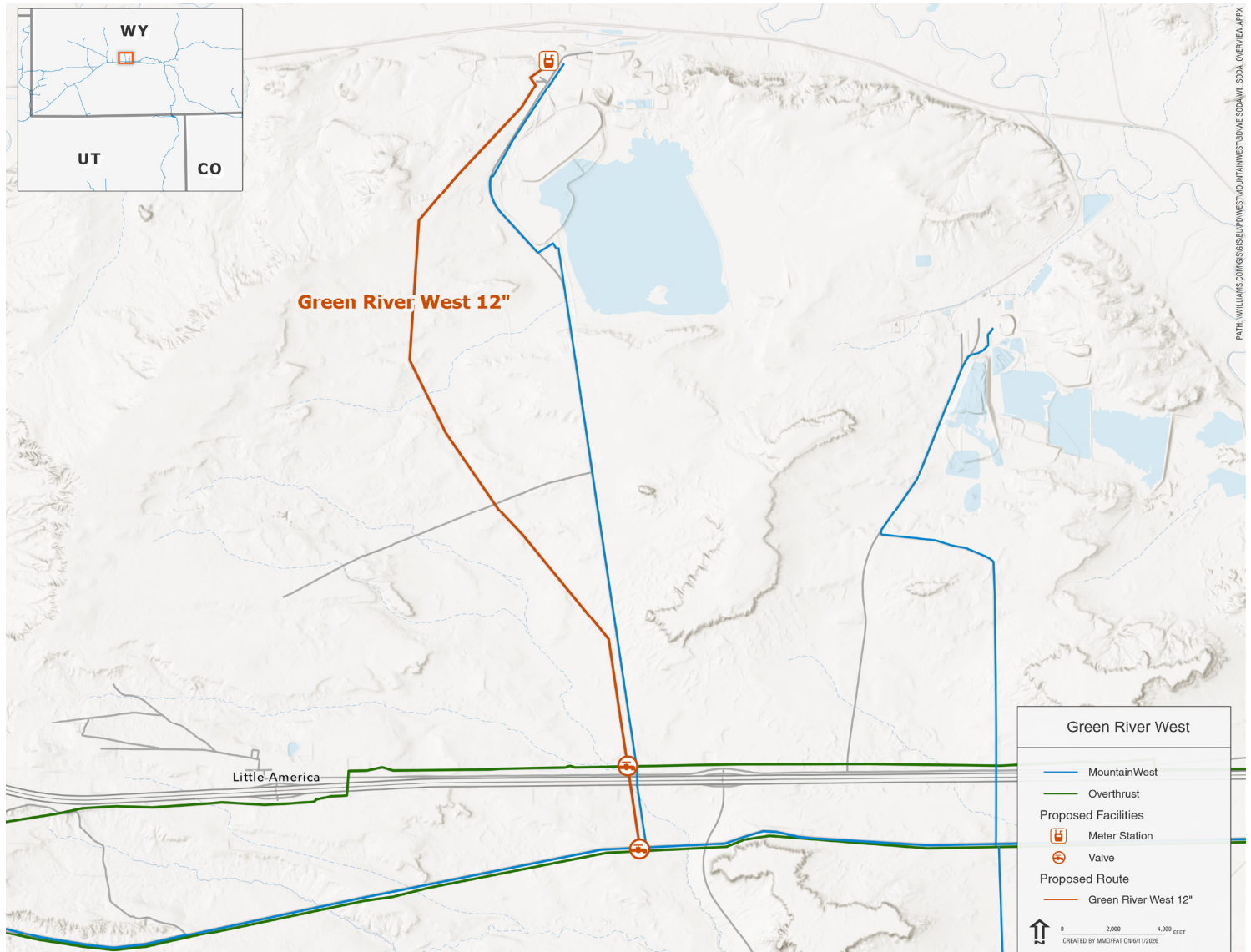
