ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Leidy Access Expansion Project, located in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, is designed to strengthen access to reliable natural gas supplies in the Northeast. By expanding infrastructure alongside existing Transco facilities where practical, the project will enhance supply access while minimizing impacts to surrounding communities and the environment.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Construction activities will follow federal safety and environmental requirements and include erosion control, restoration and monitoring.

- Installation of new pipeline
- Collocation with existing Transco transmission lines
- Use of trenchless construction methods (e.g., horizontal directional drilling) where appropriate
- Hydrostatic testing, commissioning and restoration activities

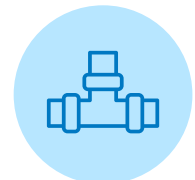

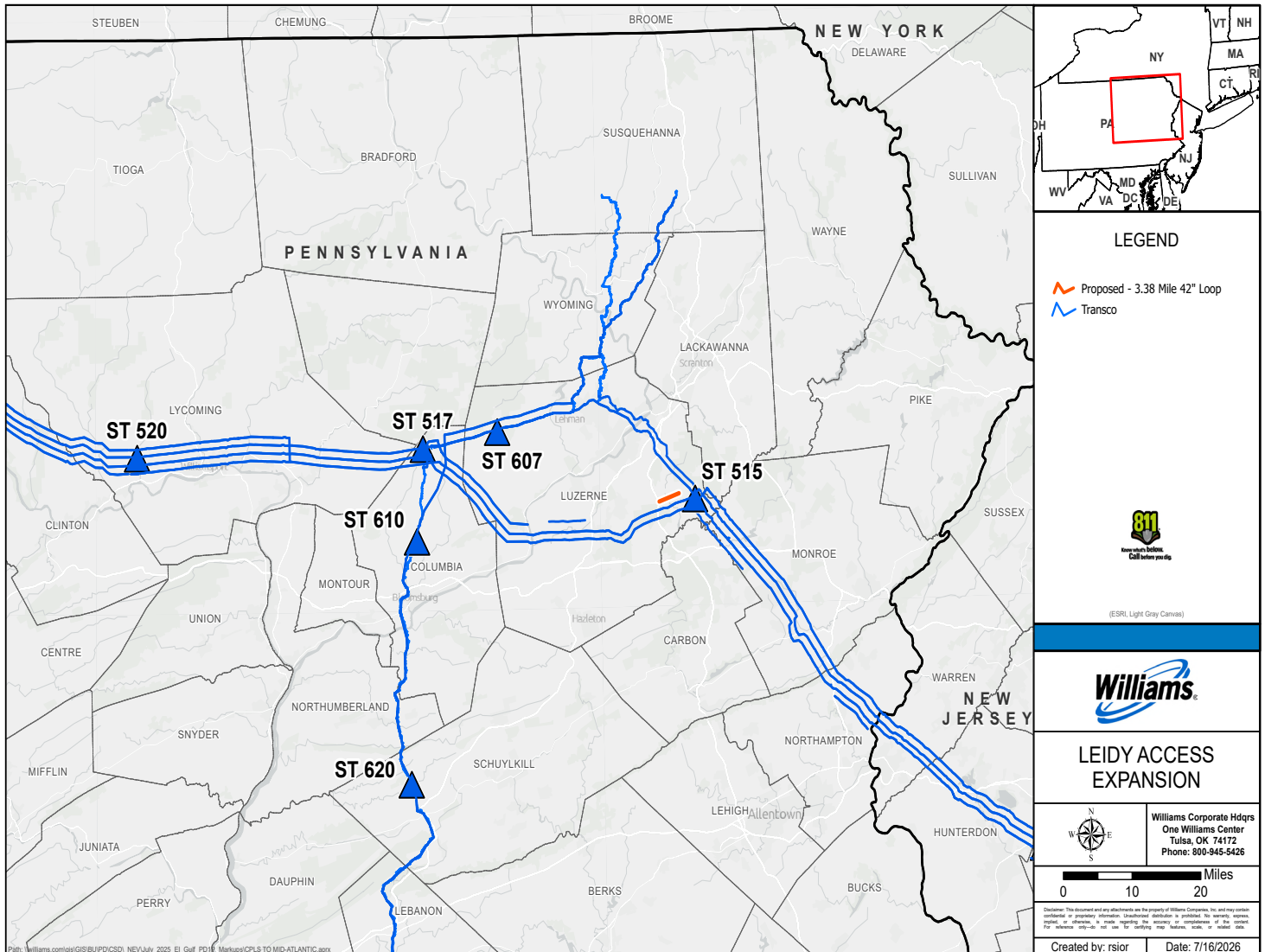
